# DO NOT BE DECEIVED BY THINGS

Part of my problem was that I had been deceived by material things. If the people coming from earth to Hades today are any indication, that situation still exists...

### **USE YOUR OPPORTUNITIES**

What a person should do is look for opportunities to serve, not be served. Looking back, I realize I had many opportunities. I also sadly realize now that each opportunity was a test of what was most important to me...

### HELL IS A TERRIBLE PLACE

That leads me to my second line of thought—the next thing I learned and want to pass on to you: Use your life for God, because "hell" is a terrible place!...

# NOW IS THE TIME TO BE CONCERNED
