II COMPANIONSHIP

- A. A great tragedy of our day is that we have too many parents that are too busy to be companions to their children.
- B. Make this resolution now: I will give my children the privilege of my companionship.
- C. Time is one the most precious gifts that we can give. Trust me, the day will come when looking back it will be time that you wish you still had.

III A CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

- A. I'm thinking primarily of the education we give them at home and with the church.
- B. Prepare them to meet infidelity and modernism.
