INTRO:

- 1. The power of the cross is verified by the resurrection. **Rom. 1:3, 4**
- 2. There would be no good news without the resurrection. 1 Cor. 15:1-4
- Jesus had taught them that he would not stay in the tomb. John 2:19-21; John 10:17,18; John 16:16-20; Matt. 12:40

I. THE RESURRECTION BROUGHT LIFE CHANGES

- A. The apostles went from men haunted by fear to men of great courage. **Acts 4:13**
- B. Followers were ready to face death themselves because they knew Jesus lived. Acts 7; Acts 21:13; Acts 12:5, 6
- C. Even some of those who put Jesus to death were converted. Acts 2:36-41

II. THE RESURRECTION POWER IS AVAILABLE TO US

A. Eph. 1:18-22.

- B. We need to know this power because it is a power that can raise us from the death of sin. **Eph. 2:1**
- C. Our baptism is a partaking of this resurrection power.Rom. 6:3-5
- D. This power is what helps us resist the devil. James 4:7, 8

III. THE RESURRECTION SERVES AS A GUARANTEE

A. 1 Cor. 15:20-26.

- B. If Christ is not risen then we are wasting our time. 1 Cor. 15:14-19; John 5:28, 29; 1 Cor. 15:23
- C. Death will be swallowed up in victory. 1 Cor. 15:42-44, 54-57
- D. 1 Cor. 15:58 is the promise of the resurrection.
