INTRO:

I. SEEK GOD'S KINGDOM BEFORE EARTHLY LUXURIES. Matt. 6:19-21

- A. I am to seek heavenly treasures. Col. 3:1-3
- B. I must stay rich toward God. Luke 12:21
- C. I cannot serve God and materialism. Matt. 6:24

II. SEEK GOD'S KINGDOM IN PREFERENCE TO THE NECESSITIES OF LIFE. Matt. 6:25-32

- A. Worrying about necessities is condemned because it questions God's providence. Matt. 6:25, 27, 28, 31, 34
- B. If we are to seek the kingdom over necessities, then think how much it should be above luxuries.

III. HOW DO WE SEEK THE KINGDOM FIRST?

- A. First we recognize our impoverished spiritual state apart from God. **Matt. 5:3**
- B. Then we turn to God and obey him. Matt. 7:21-23
- C. We continue to seek God's righteousness. Matt. 6:1; Matt. 5:6; Matt. 6:20

IV. WHY SEEK THE KINGDOM FIRST?

- A. It is beneficial to us. Matt. 6:33.
- B. Kingdom folks are heaven bound folks.

- A. We will be in the worship assemblies. Heb. 10:25
- B. We will have happier families. Eph. 5:22-6:4
- C. I will be evangelistic.
- D. It will be reflected in my giving. 2 Cor. 9:6-8
