- A. God had prophets predicting it. Dan. 2:44
- B. So important that John preached it. Matt. 3:1, 2
- C. So important that Jesus said...Matt. 6:33
- D. Jesus talked about seeing the kingdom. John 3:1-3
- E. Paul listed the blessings in the kingdom. Col. 1:13, 14

III. WHAT DID THE KEYS OPEN?

- A. There are two phases of the kingdom. Matt. 6:10; 2 Pet. 1:11
- B. The keys to the present phase.
 - 1. The apostles were to wait for power. Luke 24:46-49; Acts1:8
 - 2. That power came on Pentecost. Acts 2:1-4
 - 3. Peter used the keys. Acts 2:38
- C. Peter opened the door for the Gentiles. Acts 15:7-9
- D. Peter opened the door for backsliders. Acts 8:13, 22
- E. Peter opened the door to the eternal kingdom. 2 Pet. 1:5-11

CONC:
