- 3. This development of relationships is powerful and we need to understand it.

I. THREE STAGES IN A RELATIONSHIP.

- A. Honeymoon Everything is great!
- B. Disappointment This relationship is not perfect!
- C. Reality It is not perfect, but its good and it can work!

II. THIS PRINCIPLE APPLIED TO FAMILIAR RELATIONSHIPS.

- A. Marriage.
 - 1. You are exposed to the less than perfect side of your spouse.
 - 2. Many marriages never get past this stage.
- B. Parent Child.
- C. New Converts.
- D. Preacher Congregation.

III. WHAT CAN WE DO TO IMPROVE?

- A. We need to understand this biblical principle.
- B. Realize that building good relationships requires hard work. Luke 9:23
- C. Evaluate the probable compatibility of the relationship. Luke 14:25-33
- D. When leaving a relationship ask, "Am I running away or going somewhere?"
