

## THE KEEPER OF THE SPRING Gen. 2:18-25

## INTRO:

- 1. Henry Grady, a journalist, wrote, "the home is the capitol of America."
- 2. The problems we face today as a society can be traced to the breakdown of the home.
- 3. God intended for the home to be the keeper of the spring for all humanity.

## THE HOME WAS PLANNED FOR...

- I. ...THE CONTINUATION OF THE HUMAN RACE. Gen.1:26
  - A. Children can be produced outside of marriage, but only by paying a price. **Heb. 13:4**
  - B. Reproduction is intended as a blessing, not a curse. Psalm127:3-5
  - C. We are paying for removing the keeper of the spring.
- II. ...MEETING THE NEEDS OF MEN AND WOMEN.
  - A. Emotional needs and sex drive are both given by God 1 Cor. 7:1-4
  - B. But needs are more than physical.
  - C. The unhappiness that many feel stems from the absence of the keeper of the spring.
- III. ... THE CREATION OF A CHRISTLIKE CHARACTER.
  - A. 1 Peter 3 discusses Christian character.
  - B. To be a good husband a man needs to know himself, women in general, his wife, and God. Prov. 18:22
  - C. We need the keeper of the spring.
- IV. ... THE TRAINING OF CHILDREN.
  - A. Children must be trained. Eph. 6:1-4; Prov. 22:6.
  - B. Think of all the values that children must learn. Gal. 5:22, 23; 2 Pet. 1:5-8
  - C. Parents have the best opportunity to instill values.
- V. ...A SHARED LIFE AND AS A HAVEN OF SAFETY AND RECUPERATION.
  - A. We all need a place where we can go to be refreshed.
  - B. In Christian homes and relationships there is refreshment.
