INTRO:

- 1. The church belongs to Christ and he is its head. Matt. 16:18; Col. 1:18; Eph. 1:22, 23
- 2. He is the savior of the body. Eph. 5:23
- 3. Therefore, I have no authority try to improve on the terms of admission, the worship, the doctrine that is taught, etc. 1 Cor. 4:6; Deut.4:2; Rev. 22:18, 19
- 4. However, as a member of the Lord's church that meets here, what can I do as a human being to enhance our fellowship and improve the overall attitude and outlook of my church family?
- 6. Never, ever blame others for our own failures. I can be fruitful in spite of the bad examples and discouraging attitudes of others if I am determined to be. 1 Cor. 10:13; Matt. 27:24
- 7. Remind ourselves every day that the only way we can improve the world or the church is to begin with ourselves.
- 8. Consciously look for the good qualities in every brother and sister in Christ. When I think of a brother or sister, make a quick mental of the good points each possesses. Matt. 22:39; Rom. 12:10
- 9. Constantly strive to increase my circle of associates in the church. Try to do something good for each. **Heb. 10:24**
- 10. Every congregation has problems. I need to constantly ask myself, "Am I part of the problem, or part of the solution?" Gal. 6:1

CONC:

- 1. The church of Christ is called that because we belong to the Lord.
- 2. However, the church is composed of people and, as one of those, I have an influence on its peace, harmony, and success in God's work.
