JESUS DONATED BLOOD FOR YOU

Rev. 5:9, 10

INTRO:

1. Jesus donated his blood for each of us.
2. Jesus' blood reaches men of every race.
**Heb.2:9, 10; Rev. 5:9; John 1:29; 12:32;
2 Cor. 5:15; 1 Tim. 2:4; Matt. 28:19, 20; Gal. 3:28**
3. God wants everyone to obey him. **2 Pet. 3:9**
4. Let's contrast our donations with his.

I. OUR PINT IS A DONATION; JESUS' GIFT WAS A SACRIFICE.

- A. We get a snack and return to normal activities. Jesus died.
Mark 15:37
- B. We give what we can easily spare; Christ gave away his life's blood.
- C. Man has sinned away his right to be live. **Rom. 3:23; 6:23**
- D. Sin demands the death of the sinner. **Ezek. 18:4**
- E. Jesus gave his life for us. **Heb. 10:12**

II. OUR DONATION IS IN COMFORTABLE STERILE CONDITIONS.

- A. In your mind contrast the two scenes: a patient in a comfortable building with the best equipment; then Jesus on that cross, nearly naked, beaten and bleeding while sinful men shout for him to die.
- B. Our blood comes out of our arm via sterile needle. Jesus' blood came out of his entire body via nails and a whip.
- C. After Pilate ordered Jesus' crucifixion, Roman soldiers viciously carried it out. **Matt. 27:26; Luke 23:33**

III. OUR DONATION IS QUICK AND RELATIVELY EASY; HIS WAS DRAWN OUT AND PAINFUL.

- A. Actual blood donation takes about 10 minutes. It took Jesus 6 hours. **Mark 15:25, 34**
- B. The entire process only takes us about an hour. For Jesus it took about 21 hours – from 6:00 P.M. Thursday until 3:00 P.M. Friday.
